French counting to 16 & Home and Family

Children will learn to count from 1 to 16 using French words like *un, deux, trois...* *seize* and family names such as; *la mère* (mother), *le père* (father), *le frère* (brother)

D.T – Mechanisms

Children will design and label a wheel, consider and comment on others' designs, and think about the materials, shape, construction, and mechanisms. They will build a stable structure with a rotating wheel, test and adapt their designs, and follow a plan to make a completed model.

Geography - The UK NPP UNCR 7 & 8

In this Geography unit, children will explore:

Substantive knowledge – children will label continents, oceans, UK countries, and seas, as well as studying physical and human features.

Disciplinary knowledge - children will develop their map reading skills, using compasses and compass points, and interpreting data.

Procedural Knowledge - children will learn to apply these skills in practical activities, such as navigating using maps and compasses, and accurately recording and interpreting geographical data.

Computing – UNCR 13/17

What is a computer?

Learning about what a computer is and how they are used every day.

Children will be able to name some computer peripherals and their functions, recognise that buttons cause effects, and explain that technology follows instructions. They will recognize different forms of technology, design an invention that includes inputs and outputs, and explain the role of computers in the world around them.
