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

Year 6 performed their assembly about St. Teresa of Avila and taught us how we could use our virtues of compassion and love to do Christ's work on Earth.




Christ has no body now but yours, no hands but yours. Here on this earth yours is the work, to serve with the joy of compassion.

Pope Francis said we need to "... anoint our young people with the gift of prophecy and vision." This week, we all made a promise to make a difference and change our world for the better.










## Live Simply pledges

Year 5 news: -Year 5 have enjoyed their wonderful Anglo-Saxon learning.
















Year 6 news: -


## Miss Smyth news

As the weather is changeable now, please ensure that your child comes to school with their waterproof coats.



Correct Uniform - Winter Uniform

When we return to school, the children should wear their <u>winter</u> <u>uniform</u> i.e. **shirts/blouses and ties.** 

We also ask that children come to school in their winter PE kit on the days that they have PE.

Again, children should be in uniform for PE which is black/blue plain jogging bottoms (not patterned / not another colour), yellow t-shirt, school jumper and black or white trainers.



#### Remembrance book

We have a remembrance book in school – please add anybody you would like us to pray for to the book when you are in school. Alternatively, let school know, via email or by sending in the names on a strip of paper with your child, if you would like any names added to our book of remembrance.

What does the pastoral team do?

It is the responsibility of everybody to keep your child/ren safe in school. The Pastoral team meet fortnightly to review attendance, pastoral concerns, parent concerns, behaviour, online use, SEND needs, vulnerability for families, finance worries... and so forth... and we offer support following this. It is our job to support each child in their time at school, including supporting mental health and well-being and offering the time for children to give their perspective about what needs to change in school. This often takes place through whole class learning, pupil questionnaires, focus groups and 1:1 conversation. Children are aware of times when they can speak to our school councillor and we have a drop-in session 'talk to me Tuesdays' that every child can access. If at any time, you need support as a family, have any concerns, or need to discuss any behaviour worries, please speak to a member of the pastoral team so that we can help. We can only help if we know about it.

## Do not book holidays during term time

This is a reminder that holidays during term time are unauthorised. If you intend to take your child out of school during term time, we ask that you complete a holiday request form at least 2 weeks prior to the leave date where possible. Parents may be fined by the Local Authority for taking unauthorised leave of absence. Children need to be in school every day so please ensure holidays are only booked during school holiday time.

Term dates are on this newsletter and on the website.

Good attendance, continues to be a school and government priority.

Remember below 95% is a concern and below 90% is classed as persistent absence. If you have any problems with regards to getting your child to school or you are struggling to improve your child's attendance, please speak to Mrs. Yorke or Mrs. Davis.
