Entering School on Wet Mornings

Some new parents may be uncertain about the routine for coming into school on particularly wet or snowy/ icy mornings. Between 8:30 – 8:43:

INFANT children should enter through the front doors and go straight to their classroom where an adult will be waiting.

JUNIOR children will enter via the side gate and cross the playground to their relevant classrooms where, again, an adult will be waiting.

The staff on duty will also be at the doors and gate to welcome the children in. If you are uncertain, please speak with a more experienced parent who will hopefully direct you! Thank you.

Late arrivals (after 8:43) – Infant or Junior – will need to come in through the main entrance and parents of the children 'log in' to the new system as explained in last week's newsletter.
