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


Y3 Mass - conversion of St. Paul - 25.1.23

Reception class have been comparing lengths of objects and talking about who is taller or shorter.










Year 1 news: Year 1 have been creating arrays, to show repeated addition.








Year 2 news: Year 2 have produced some wonderful writing this week.







Year 3 have been designing their own characters for an adventure story.



Year 4 have been peer marking each others' English writing.








Year 5 news: Year 5 have enjoyed learning about the parables and their meanings.


