Kidz.comm – support at end of term – summer opening

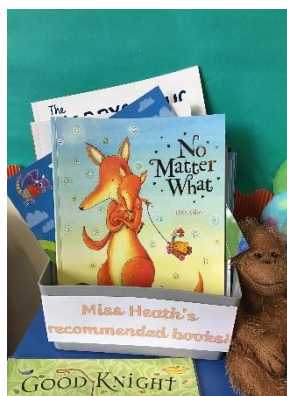

Our customary 'bridge' of children's hands will not be allowed either, but there will be a 'guard of honour' of some kind for our Y6 children as they leave us at the end of the day.


Special Celebration this Friday
