and to be quick to follow you.



Year 1 had fun outside exploring number lines. They really enjoyed their practical maths and fresh air!








Year 2 news: -

Year 2 have been learning about why exercise is important for our bodies.








Year 3 news: -

Year 3 have been learning about fables this week - comparing characteristics to write their own.








Year 4 news: -

Thinking Day - 22.2.24








Zumba is an aerobic dance class. The routines feature Latin American moves and music.
