All parents are welcome to attend.

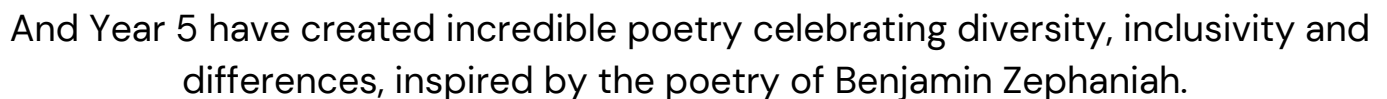


St. John Paul II Feast Day
