	<p><i>London Skyline</i> Children will mix primary colours and use printing to create a London skyline inspired by the Great Fire of London.</p>	<p><i>Warhol Hand Prints</i> After learning about Andy Warhol and the pop art movement, children will create their own pop art repeated print.</p>	<p><i>Mendi Patterns</i> The children will show pattern and texture by using dots and a variety of line patterns.</p>	<p><i>Mondrian</i> Based on the work of Piet Mondrian, children will create their own abstract composition focusing on use of primary colours.</p>	<p><i>Picasso</i> This half term, the children will study Picasso, the pioneer of cubism, and create their own final pieces based on his work 'Le Coq'.</p>	<p><i>Boat Paper Sculptures</i> Building on their use of paper to create sculptures in year 1, the children will use rolling, cutting and folding to create a sea sculpture.</p>
