### **Covid-19:**

*In line with Public Health England, and all other bodies who are currently discussing this situation, we are encouraging the children to wash their hands thoroughly using the soap dispensers we have purchased for them. While we have a significant amount of soap in school at present, we are finding it very difficult to get more supplies. The children have been spoken to about not wasting this soap and playing with it. However, enormous amounts are being found in the sinks or on the floor and it is running out. Please speak to your child about courtesy and respect for school property/resources to support us in keeping them safe. Thank you!*

### **Before School Dropoff**

I received an email last week from a concerned relative of a child at our school. It seems that a couple of weeks ago a reception child was left wandering around outside school before the gates were open. The person who contacted school made sure the child went in through the gates once open but the parent/carer was nowhere to be seen. Unfortunately, no names are known but this matter is very serious.

**Therefore, so that we are all very clear, the following is expected in order to keep our children safe:**

- 1] Adults **must** accompany their child until the school gates are opened and staff members are in their place of supervision.
- 2] NO child should be expected to come into the school alone – this includes children who are late – the adult must register them on the school system.
- 3] The sole remit of staff on the gate is the supervision of the children. If you need to pass on a message, go to the school office; please do not attempt to speak to the member of staff on duty.
- 4] Until the child has been passed over to a school member of the staff team, the parent/carer has total responsibility for him/her. As stated last week, please be vigilant with them and their whereabouts.
