The Spiritual Council also consult their classmates on their thoughts and feelings regarding spirituality in school.

Mrs Davis (Deputy Headteacher) is the teacher responsible for this committee.

All members of the Spiritual Council are expected to:

- Strengthen the spiritual life of the school with the Deputy Headteacher
- Monitor the quality of prayer and collective worship, RE classroom displays and prayer areas across the school
- Plan and lead class, key stage and whole school prayer and liturgy
- Be an example of Christ's teaching to others
- Follow the Gospel values
- To represent all different types of religion in the school
- Meet regularly to develop prayer and liturgy within our school
- Lead prayer groups during break and lunchtimes e.g. rosary club, 'Faith Friends'
- Disseminate messages to their classes and/or house groups
- Attend our places of worship to develop our own faith every week
- Be living examples of our mission statement
